- Altos come in on 22
- M 30 Alto 1–Eb, Alto 2 on Eb

P.7

Bottom of page 76-m79. Altos start on Group 1, but say 2x
"Come on Inside" sustaining through m77. Basically, we say it with down beats on Group 1 and Group 3-Come on In-side, Come on In-side

P.8

- M88 on..Alto 1 All G-then descend by phrase, to F then Eb
- Have to double check my notes(!) but Alto 2 starts on Eb I believe, same descending sequence by phrase.

P. 15

- Replaces "Now you've" with "Sidney's"
- Lower octave for the first two bars on each stanza
- Higher octave for the last two bars on each stanza

Driving rhythm, listen to the accompaniment

P. 14

- M166-167 Harmony All Altos on G
- M168-169 Alto 1 goes to A, Alto 2 stay on G

P. 15

- M170 Harmony— A Bb A Bb-down a third from melody
- On "Careful"—attack each one afresh—hyperventilate

- Keep Pick-up
- M15 A#

P. 3

• M 33-"Ain't" is long, "Sport" is short, don't emphasize the T at the end

P.5

- Splat–T is at end of beat 4
- Pay attention

P. 6

- M 74 Dallas-cut off on beat 3
- M75 White–very short, with a punch

P.7

- M90 A#
- M84–87all on B, except for "already"-- when we're in unison
- Sing "dead" more ugly, then "don't you know" as an aside.

P.8

• Sustain top of page for TWO bars, on the word "Fall"

P. 14

- M171-173 lower line, cross off the tie
- M174 Alto 1 on A, Alto 2 on E
- M176 short!

P. 15

- M187 Altos on B
- M189 "be" cut off on beat 3!
- M196 Cut the "yeah" at the end
